## REC AND PARK DISTRICT TO HOST ROTW ACTIVE TRANSPORTATION PLAN WORKSHOP ON SEPTEMBER 21, 2016

The Rim of the World Recreation and Parks District is kicking off the ROTW Active Transportation Plan with a community-wide workshop on Wednesday,

September 21 from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. The Rim of the World Active Transportation Plan will identify opportunities for people to walk, bike, and use other forms of active transportation throughout the Rim Communities. The final Rim of the World Active Transportation Plan will identify priority projects to create a more connected, safe, and active community.

The September 21st workshop will be held at Rim of the World High School (27400 California 18, Lake Arrowhead) and will be the first community-wide workshop for the public to participate in the creation of the Active Transportation Plan. The workshop will include a summary of previous community engagement input from pop-up workshops in Crestline, Running Springs, and Lake Arrowhead and exercises and activities for participants to offer input on ideas, opportunities, and challenges for riding, walking, biking, and horseback riding in Rim communities.
